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SPARKLING

HOWARD PINOT CHARDONNAY VINTAGE SPARKLING

BTL 52.00

2020 // Adelaide Hills

Notes Tom Northcott is both winemaker and owner of this cool climate Adelaide Hills winery. This region has a reputation of producing extremely high quality Pinot Noir and Chardonnay for his sparkling base. This region in close proximity to the city but high enough in the ranges produces sparkling wines of great intensity.

Light salmon colour with fresh apple and summer strawberries. This wine has high natural acidity resulting in a fresh vibrant wine.

ROSÉ

ETE ROSÉ

2019 // Pay D'Oc, France

GLS 11.00 // BTL 44.00

Notes The French Rose Tsunami continues to rise. Unheralded 10 years ago now everything fashionable is pink. Ete is translated as "Summer" and everything associated with it, is found in this wine. This wine hails from slightly warmer Pay D'Oc region and is made from 100% Grenache which gives the wine, spice and warmth.

The wine has delicious aromas of spiced cherries with an edge of savouriness on the palate.

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WHITE WINE

TORZI MATTHEWS FROST DODGER RIESLING

GLS 12.00 // BTL 48.00

2020 // Eden Valley

Notes A deeply frost pocketed region in Eden Valley. It is an extremely approachable young white wine with an incredible depth and purity.

This is an intense hand crafted Riesling which has vibrant juicy citrus flavours and beautiful texture on the palate. It has refreshing acid which will enhance food.

LANA PINOT GRIGIO

GLS 10.00 // BTL 40.00

2019 // King Valley

Notes A great example of modern Pinot Grigio. Made by the Pizzini family in King Valley VIC. The family were pioneers of the variety. Lana is named after the town in Italy where the family originally resided. Pinot Grigio is such a flexible wine style.

This as intense green apple and pear. It has lively zippy acid and a clean refreshing finish.

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WHITE WINE

MAHI SAUVIGNON BLANC

GLS 12.00 // BTL 48.00

2018 // Marlborough, NZ

Notes A Kiwi Sauvignon Blanc with plenty of expression and texture. Rather than focussing on fruit alone the nature of this wine is that it has spent a small amount of time fermented in old French oak. This technique provides additional weight combined with a wild yeast added giving the wine a savoury note to balance out the intense fruit.

Beautifully balanced and perfect for light curry dishes.

YERING VILLAGE CHARDONNAY

GLS 13.00 // BTL 52.00

2018 // Yarra Valley

Notes There are three wines that are synonymous with the Yarra Valley. Sparkling Wine, Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Each has a pretty impressive pedigree. The wine is in honour of the first settlers who made the region home.

Sourced entirely from Upper Yarra it has distinctive it has creamy white peach and pear tempered with refreshing acidity and a lovely minerally, savoury finish

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RED WINE

YERING VILLAGE PINOT NOIR

GLS 13.00 // BTL 52.00

2018 // Yarra Valley

Notes Yering was the Victoria's first vineyard planted in 1838. In its current inception it rates as one of the most consistent producers of a variety commonly known as the "Holy Grail". This is a super fragrant Pinot Noir.

Dark black cherries and plums jump out of the glass with the additional complexity of sage and dried herbs. Beautifully balanced on the palate with finely grained tannins giving a wonderful elegant finish.

JERICO GSM (GRENACHE SHIRAZ MOURVEDRE)

GLS 13.00 // BTL 52.00

2017 // McLaren Valley

Notes One of the most exciting emerging producers from South Australia in the past 10 years. This is a true family affair with Father, 2 sons and a daughter involved from go to whoa. Neil Jericho has 40 plus years in the industry and this wine is a legacy to his children. Not a bad inheritance!! Predominately Grenache with a small component of Shiraz and Mourvedre, its juicy delicious Grenache meeting the solid spice core of Shiraz.

Highly perfumed with lip smacking savoury characters, this is a beautifully crafted Rhone style blend.

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RED WINE

MT LANGI CLIFF EDGE SHIRAZ

GLS 15.00 // BTL 60.00

2017 // McLaren Valley

Notes

Where do you begin with this wine. Mt Langi was one of the pioneers in Australia of "cool climate Shiraz". When most other wineries were increasing their alcohol content and residual sugar, these guys were pushing elegance and power. Naturally palates change and now it's about finesse.

The hallmarks of this wine is it's dark spice core, melting tannins and an unusual pink musk character. Affectionately known as "Baby Langi" it's the little brother of the famous Ghiran brother.

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RED WINE

XANADU ESTATE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

GLS 16.00 // BTL 64.00

2018 // Margaret River

Notes

What superlatives are left to describe Margaret River. A mecca for surfing and high quality reds and whites. This coastal region 3 hours South of Perth is renowned for elegant yet powerful Cabernet Sauvignon dominant reds. with both finesse and power. Estate Cabernet Sauvignon with a small portion of Malbec and Petit Verdot is one of the most awarded wines made by the winery. It continues the pedigree of inky dark reds with a core of blackcurrant and a plus finish on the palate.

This wine and it has had an impressive show record winning the Jimmy Watson Trophy 2 years ago for the best 1-2 year old red in the country with the 2016 vintage, and amassing best Cabernet Trophy at the National Wine Show in Canberra for a number of years.
